BACKGROUND :

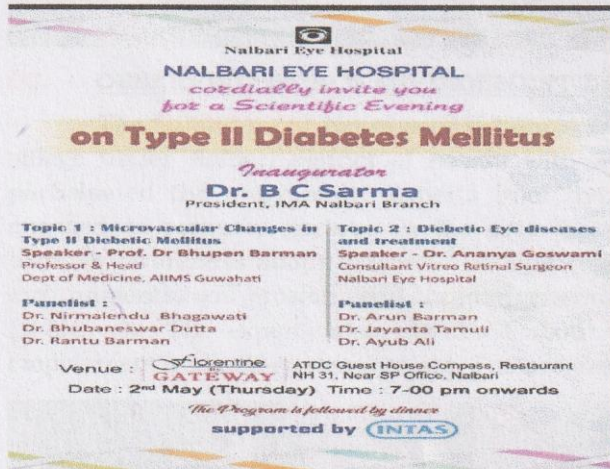
The “UDDIPANA” is a Voluntary Non-Govt. Organization of Assam was Registered on 16th February, 2011 under Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860, Vide Registration No.- RS/ NAL/ 246/ G/ 141 of 2010-2011.

As the Society is a Socio-Economic Voluntary Organization, it has been working since its inception i.e. 2011 in the field of all-round Developments aspect according to the Chief aim and objectives for the purpose of which the Society initially constituted.

The following activities are performed in the aspect of all-round social development during the year-2023-24.

01. ORGANIZING A SCIENTIFIC EVENING ON TYPE-II DIABETES MELLITUS :

The “UDDIPANA” has organized a Scientific Evening on Type-II Diabetes Mellitus at Florentine by Gateway, Nalbari on 2nd May, 2023 in Association with Nalbari Eye Hospital. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. B.C. Sarma, President IMA, Nalbari. The programme was discussed about Hyperglycemia, or elevated blood sugar, is a part of type 2 diabetes that can result in complications affecting various organs and increased risk of heart disease. While patient may not be able to control all risk factors for type 2 diabetes, he/ she can help prevent it through a healthy lifestyle and diet. There are 100 nos. of senior Ophthalmologist Scientist were attended the programme. The programme was good impact among all the participants.



02. ORGANIZING COMMUNITY EYE CARE PROGRAMME FOR CHILDREN :

In India, every year several thousands of children lose their vision, partially or completely, to preventable causes. The **"UDDIPANA"** is an initiative that strives to ensure that every child who has a problem with his or her eye sight has access to healthcare and no child needlessly turns blind. The Community Eye Care Program for children was conceptualized and instituted by Nalbari Eye Hospital, who are pioneers in the field of community eye care for children's on 15th May, 2023 at Nalbari. The program called the Happy Eyes project is supported by the supply of spectacles by few Re-known Companies. The **"UDDIPANA"** takes care of surgical needs of student and strives to keep them free of eye disorders, who are officially trained and certified, volunteer in the primarily screening of students. Nalbari Eye Hospital and the NGO work in tandem to cover a large population of students from different districts. The project involved the activities, primary and secondary screening for eye related problems followed by treatment for the identified children.



03. OBSERVED "WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY" :

The **"UDDIPANA"** has observed **"World Environment Day"** on 5th June, 2023 at Moiradanga village under Nalbari district of Assam with a Programme on Tree Plantation. 50 people were participated the programme. Experts from the Department of Forests and reputed NGOs were engaged as resource persons in the programme. Resource persons highlighted the programme through awareness about deforestation and regeneration of forests, plantation of trees to control environments, soil erosion, and income generation through Joint Forest Management Committee (JFMC) etc. The experts also explained about various government sponsored schemes for self-employment and self-sustenance etc. The programme was had a good impact to the participants.



04. AWARENESS GENERATION PROGRAMME ON SUPPORT FOR EDUCATION TO GIRL'S CHILD :

The **"UDDIPANA"** has performed an awareness generation programme on support for education to girl's child at Namati village under Nalbari district of Assam on 9th October, 2023. 115 girl's students from different schools attended the programme. The main topics of the programme was promotion of quality education, technical education, importance of education for girl's child in modern society, and scholarships to the meritorious and poor students. Resource persons from Social Welfare Department, Nalbari district were invited in the programme. The experts explained the details of the topics to the participants during the programme. The programme had a good impact to the participants and was successful.



05. ORGANIZING MEGA FREE EYE CHECK-UP CAMP :

The **"UDDIPANA"** has organized a Mega free Eye Check-up Camp at Na-Basti village under Baksa, BTR district of Assam on 25th January, 2024 in collaboration with Nalbari Eye Hospital. The Eye Camp was inaugurated President of the Society and he explained about Health Programme taken by the Nalbari Eye Hospital and appeal to people take advantage from it. There are 258 nos. of patients were treated by the Camp and free medicines were distributed among all the patients by the Society.



06. CONDUCTING SEMINAR ON DIABETIC RATINOPATHY :

Diabetic retinopathy is an eye condition, it is caused by diabetes that occurs due to damage to the blood vessels in the retina, the light-sensitive tissue at the back of the eye. When diabetes is not well managed, it can lead to high levels of blood sugar, which in turn can cause damage to blood

vessels throughout the body including those in the retina. For discussion about the problem of Diabetic Retinopathy, the **“UDDIPANA”** has conducting a Seminar on Diabetic Retinopathy at Nalbari Eye Hospital on 15th February, 2024. Dr. Ananya Goswami was attended the programme as Resource person and she vividly discussed the cause and prevention of Diabetic Retinopathy. The programme had good impact among the participants.



07. MEETINGS :

In addition of the meeting and seminar held on special occasions. The Society held 8 nos. of Executive Body meetings and one time of General Body meeting during the year 2023-24.
